MATERIALIST VIEW OF HISTORY**

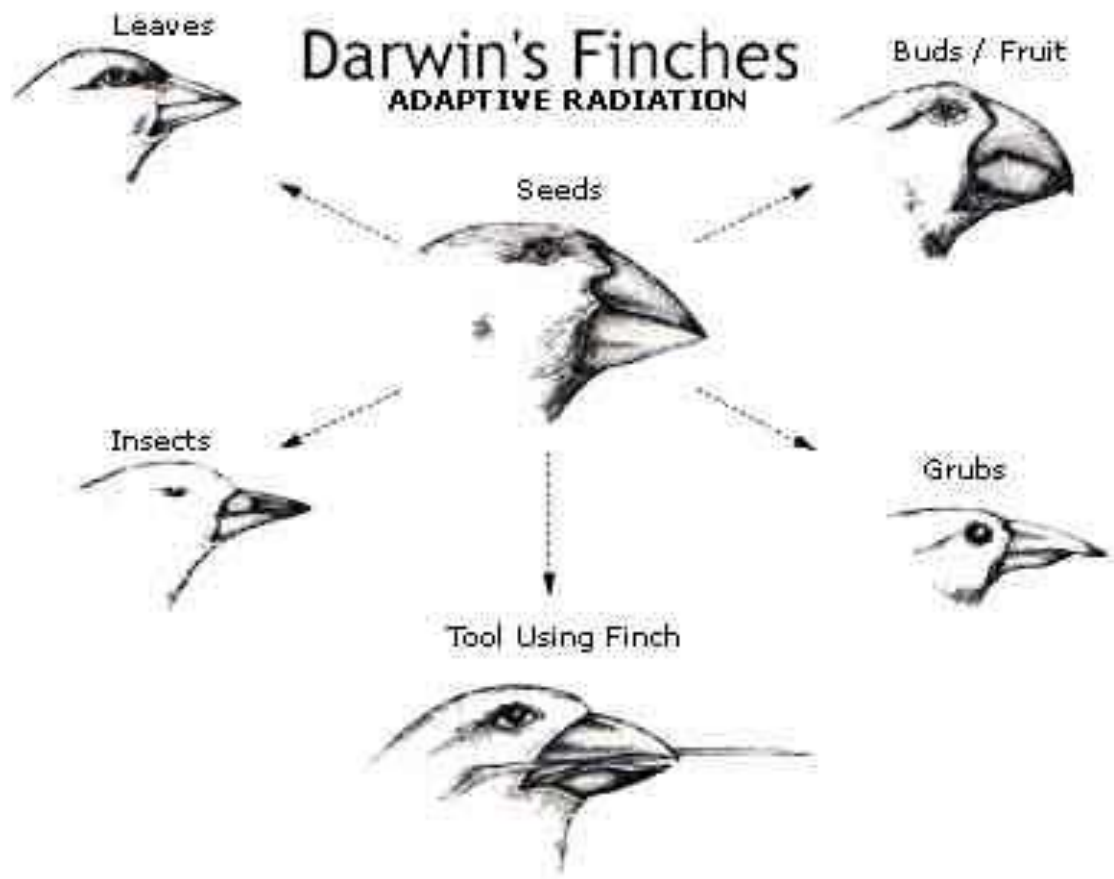


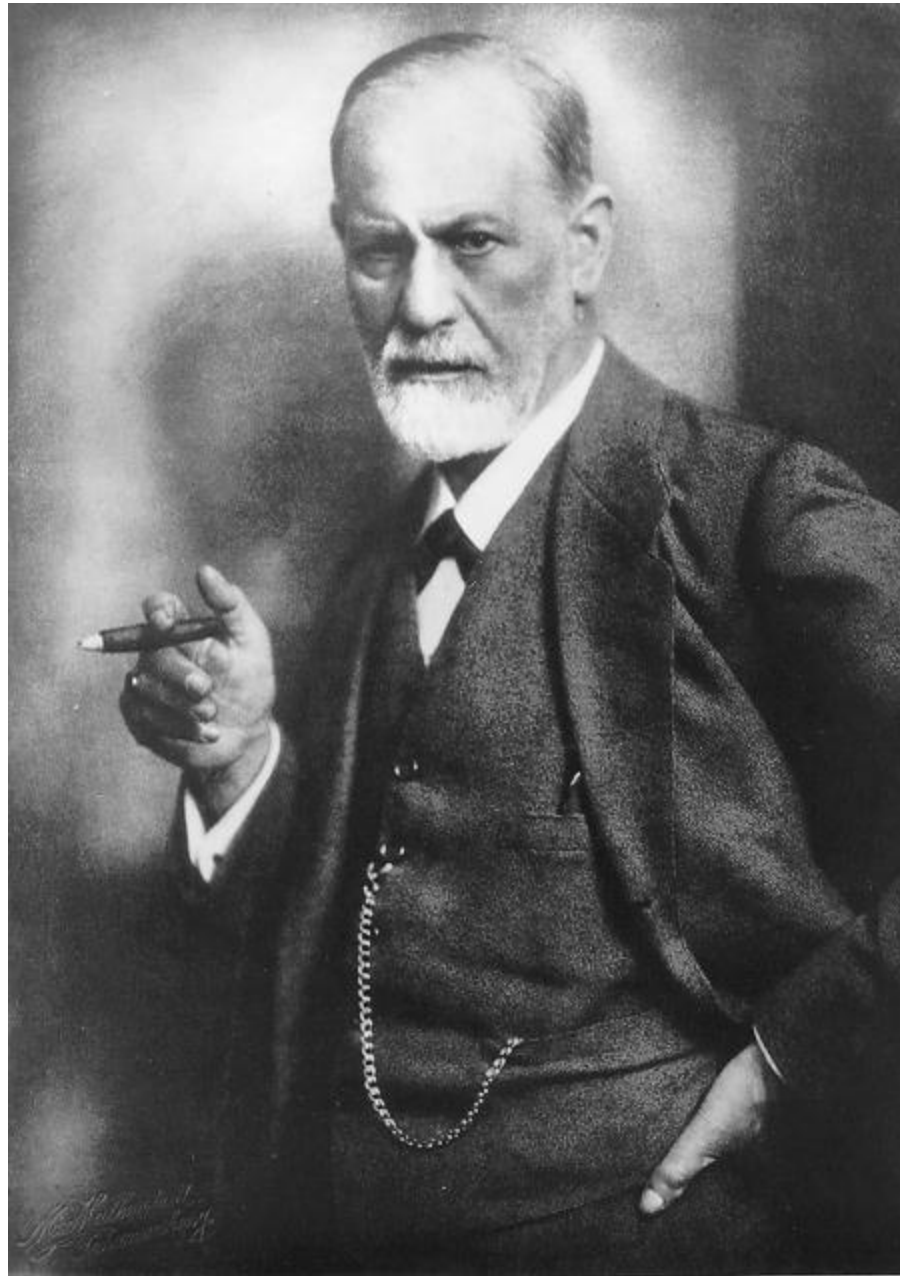

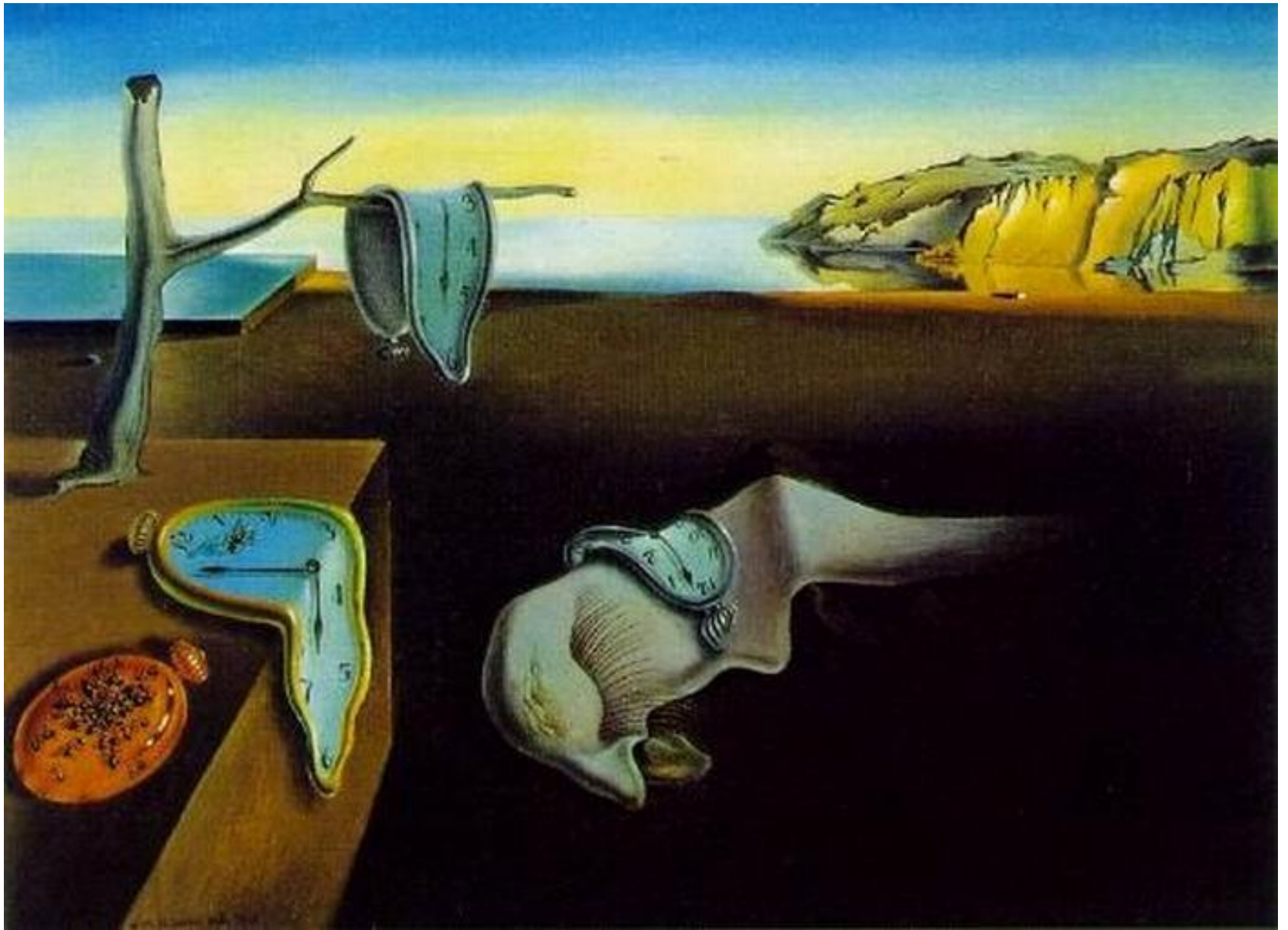
In 1916, in a photographer's shop-window they used in which the faces of the persons photographed were replaced by different heads. This technique was characteristic of Berlin Dada, an development of Cubist collage, from which it the use of printed text elements and photographs of the term "montage" was chosen deliberately in the works of any "artistic" character. After that, there to the Dadaists, could a new (mechanical) art appear, which would stand up for a mechanical, rational and ultimately peaceful world.



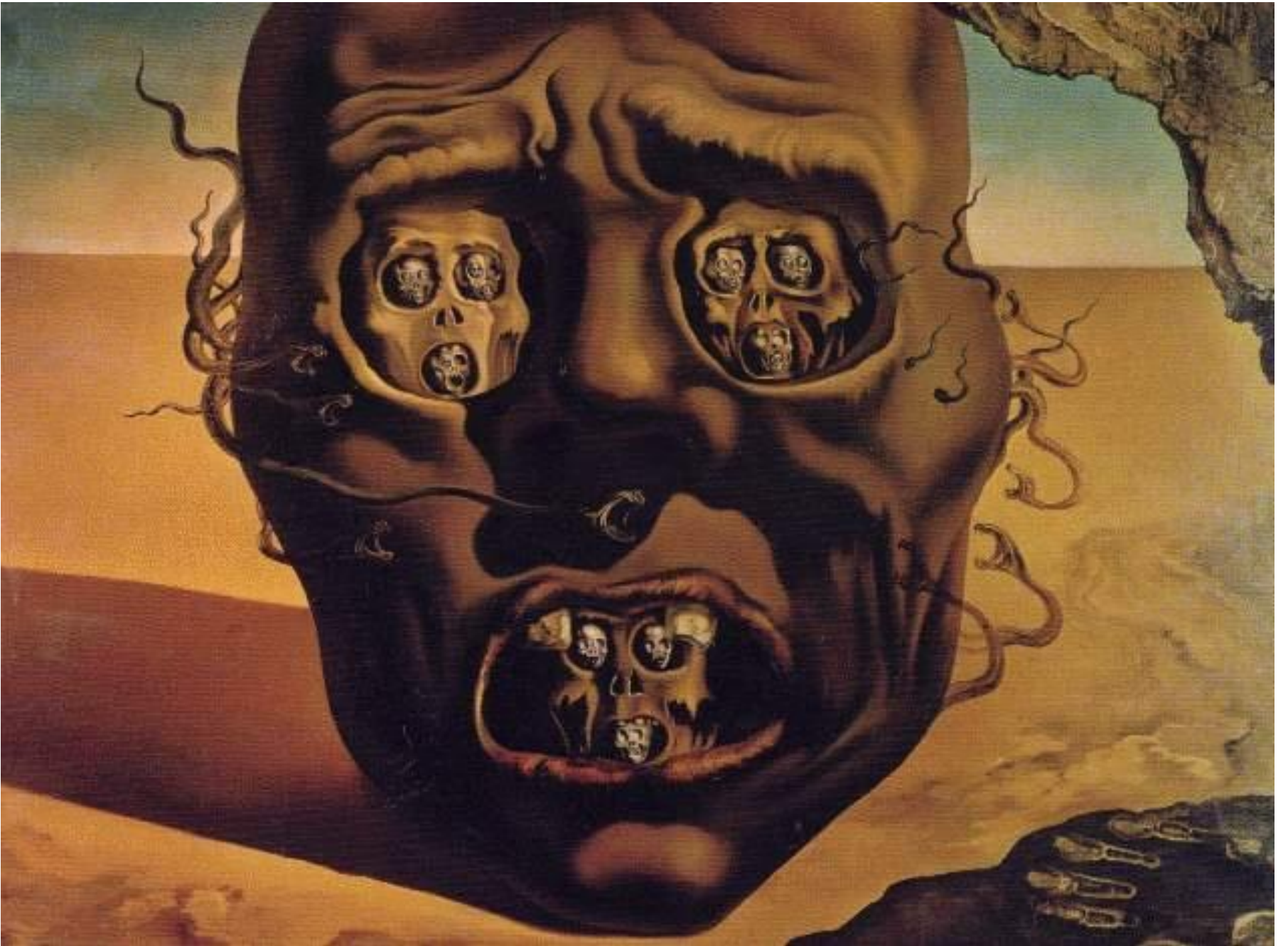

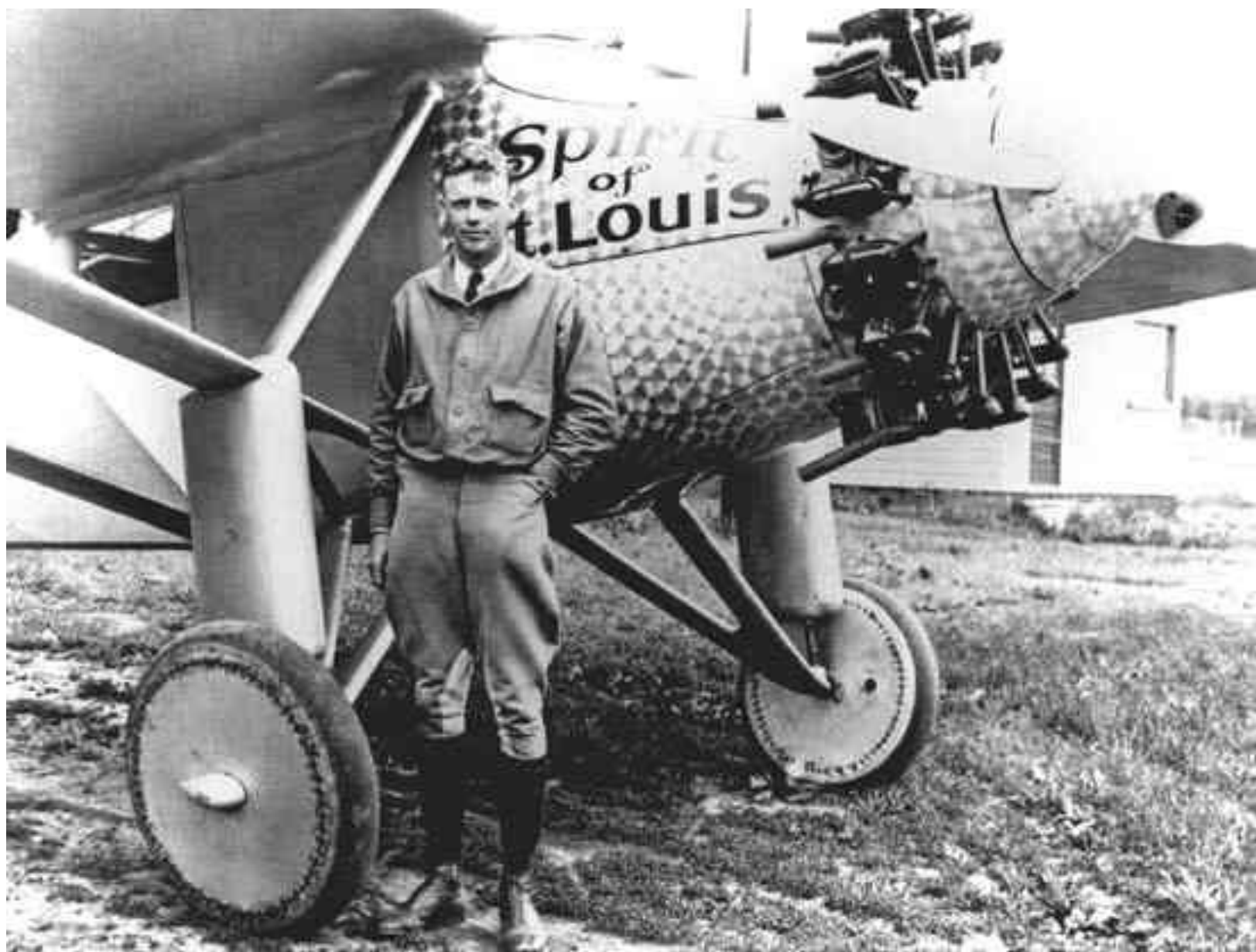

Article 231.

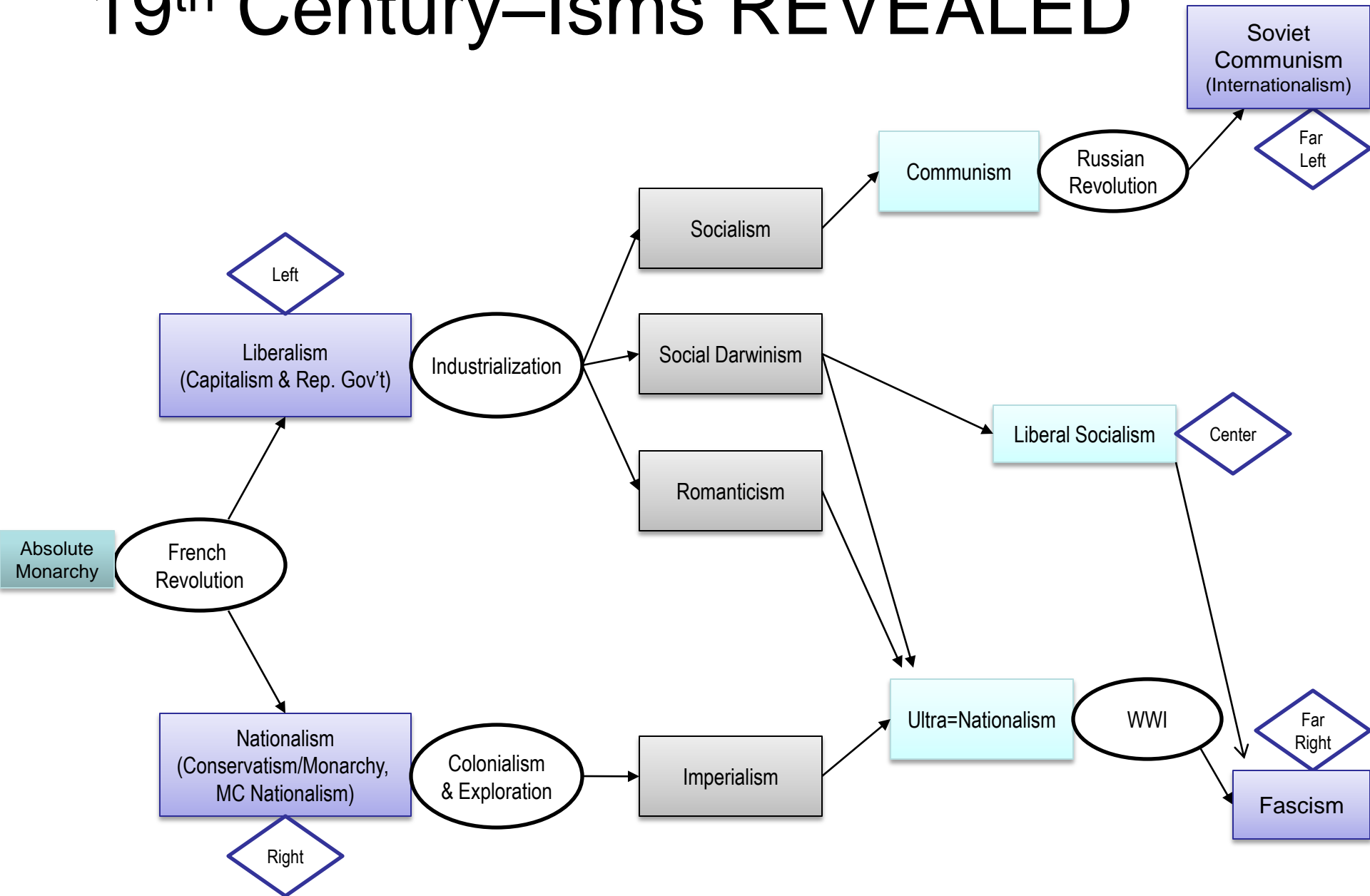
The Allied and Associated Governments confirm and Germany accepts the responsibility of Germany and her allies for causing all the loss and damage to which the Allied and Associated Governments and their nationals have been subjected as a consequence of the war imposed upon them by the aggression of Germany and her allies.

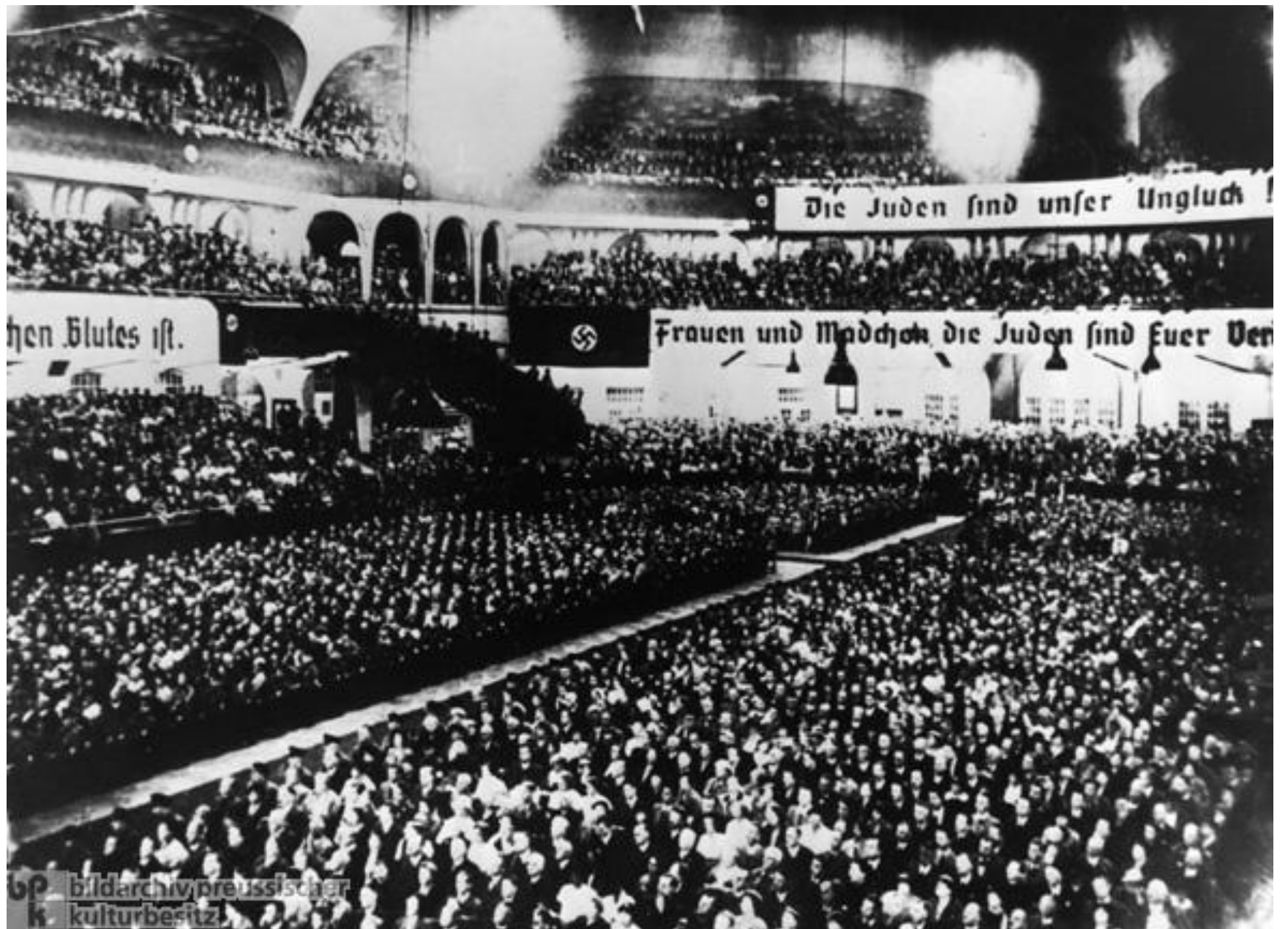
Article 232.

The Allied and Associated Governments recognize that the resources of Germany are not adequate, after taking into account permanent discriminations of such resources.



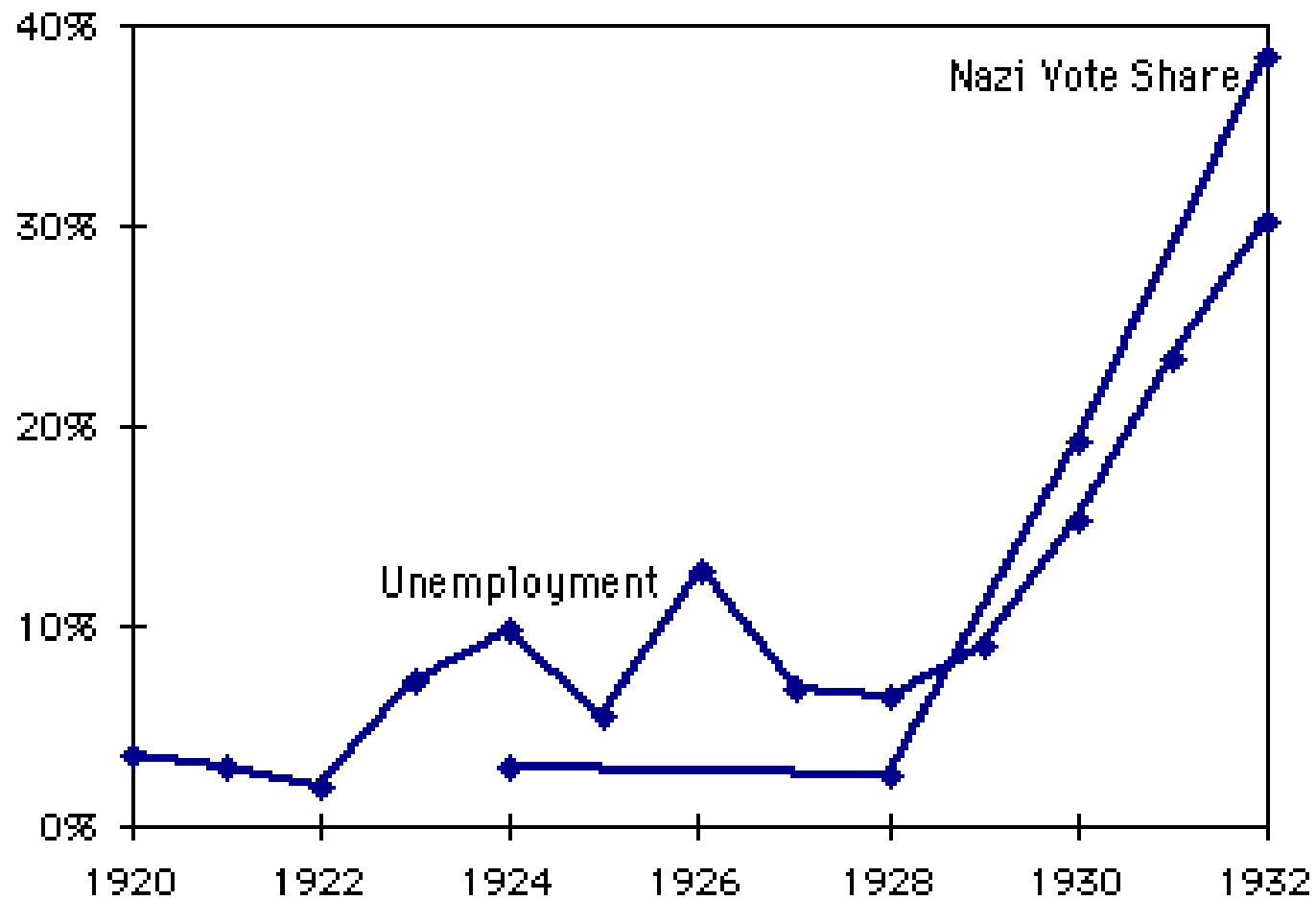
